## Mahler and Lewitt Studios Residency




The brief specifies that the challenge is to physically to connect the two houses to create one building. The design should be environmentally responsible in the use of sustainable materials and renewable energy.

















Sketch design process


This residency includes 4 bedrooms with private bathrooms, 4 studio spaces which can be expanded or contracted by moving the sliding doors.

There is only one kitchen which is the heart of the residency connected to a open living room with seating.

The gallery is the largest space and the most important, it is a sensory flexible moving space.

Continually adapting to each new exhibition. The roof of the building has solar panels so the site can generate renew-able energy.






Proposed Axonometric








Lower ground floor plan
