"Your House" demonstrates conceptual clarity through its exploration of nostalgia as a shared yet contrasting experience between adults and children.

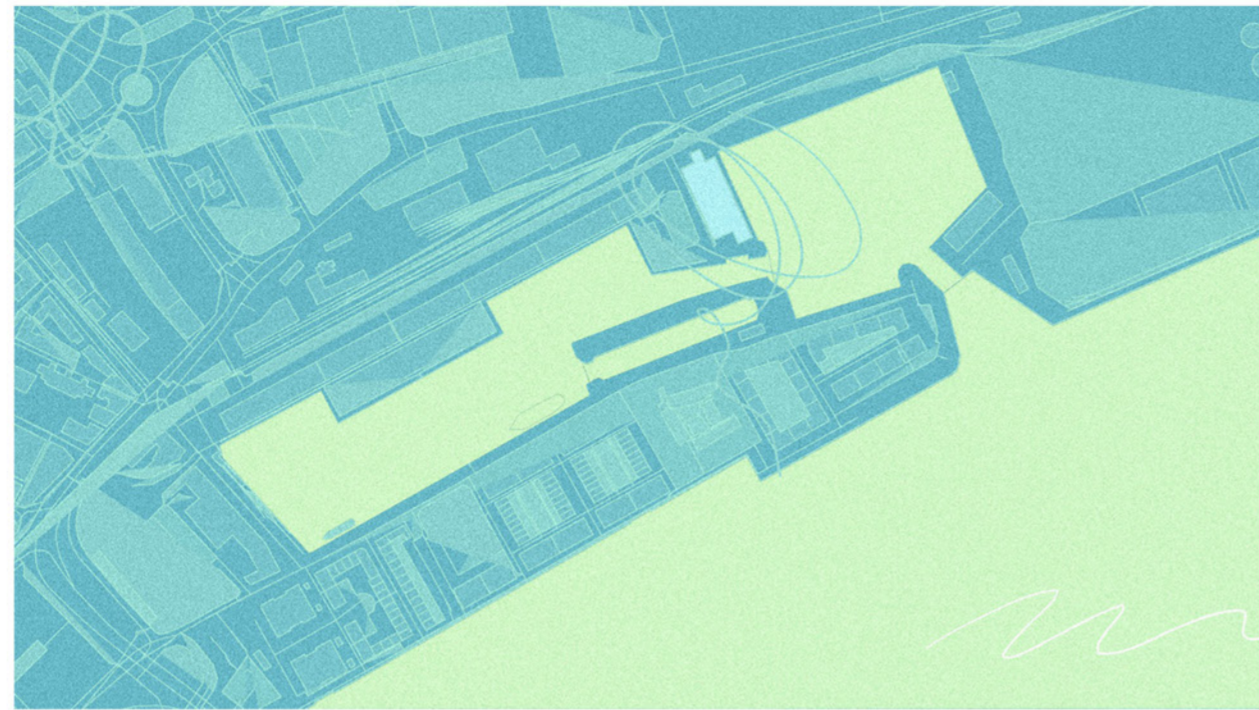
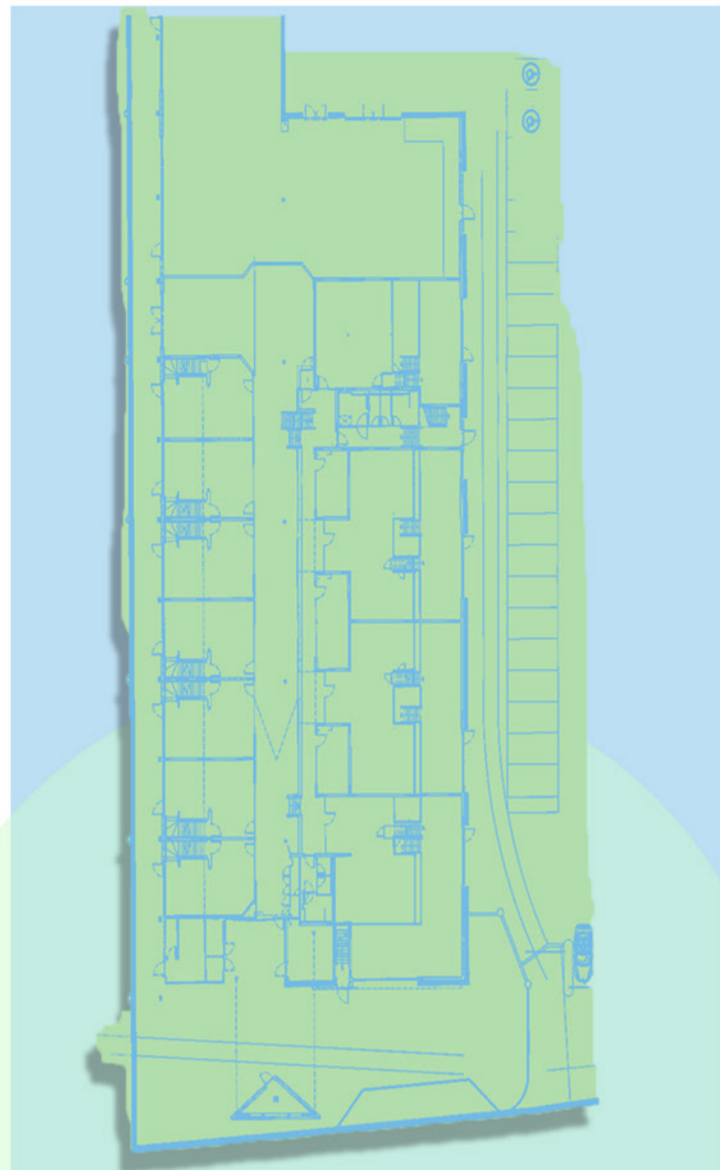
the spatial strategy carefully sequences visitors through welcoming, exploratory, creative, and reflective zones, encouraging interaction and connection.

atmosphere is shaped by the waterside setting of shed 25 watersedge, dundee. soft forms, natural light, and tactile materials, creating a calm yet inspiring environment.

the nostalgic art studio prioritises inhabitation and sensory experience through flexible family centred spaces that supports creativity, play, and memory making.

instead of focusing only on visual outcomes, the design considers how people feel, move, interact, and create together, reflecting a deep understanding of interior space as an experiential practice.

the colour scheme of blue, green and white are nostalgic colours as they are tied with human psychology and the natural world.

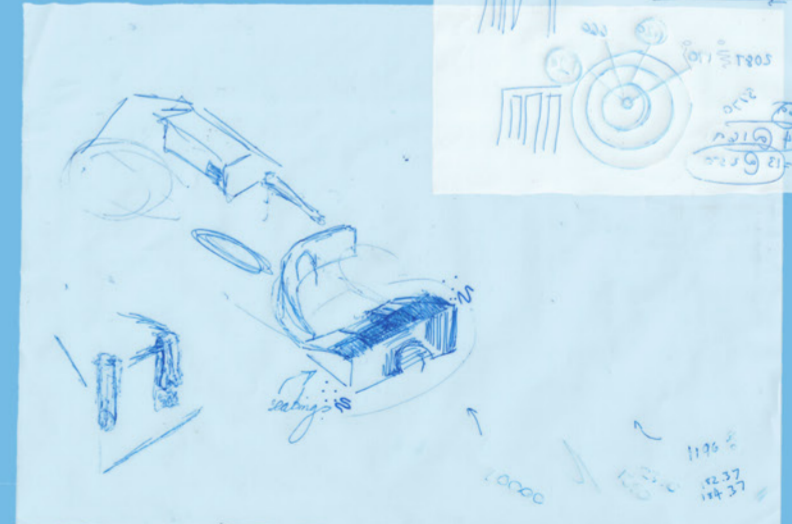
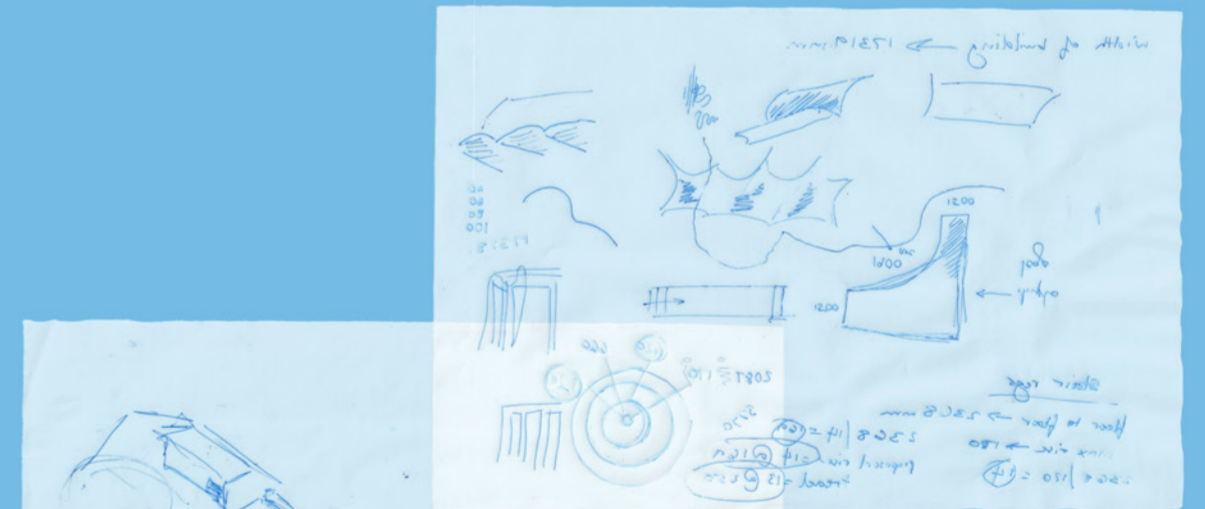
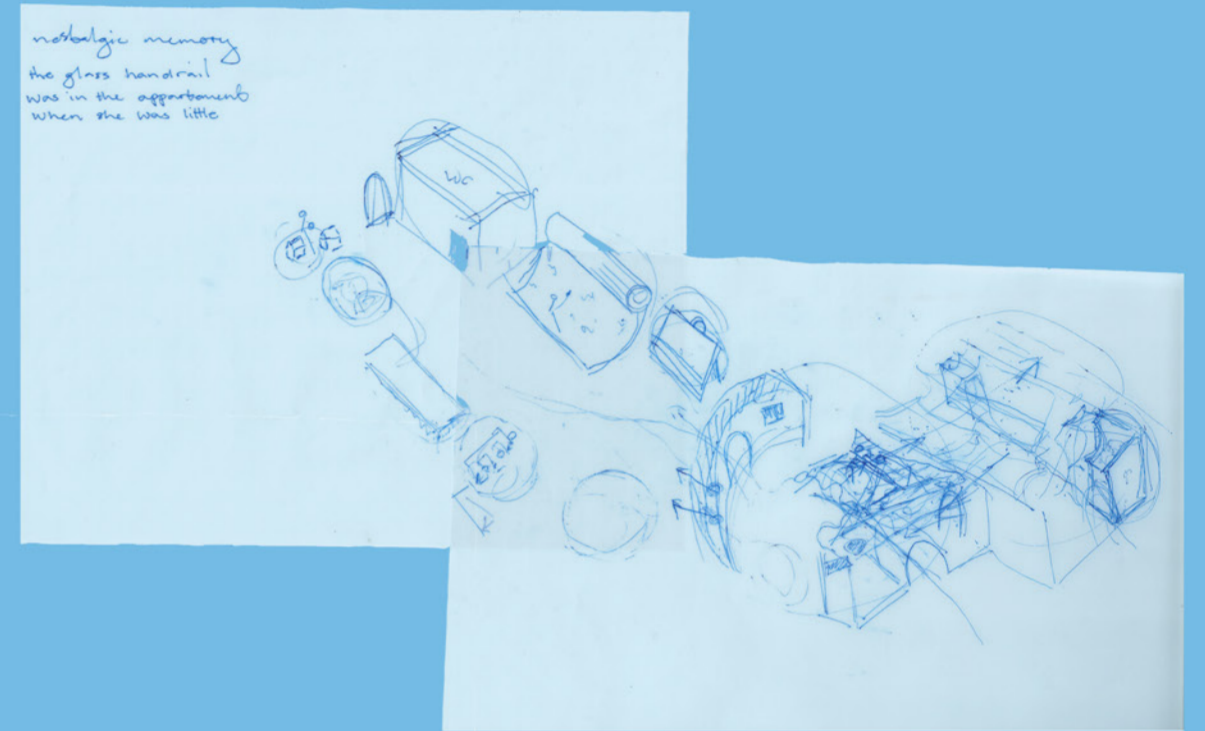
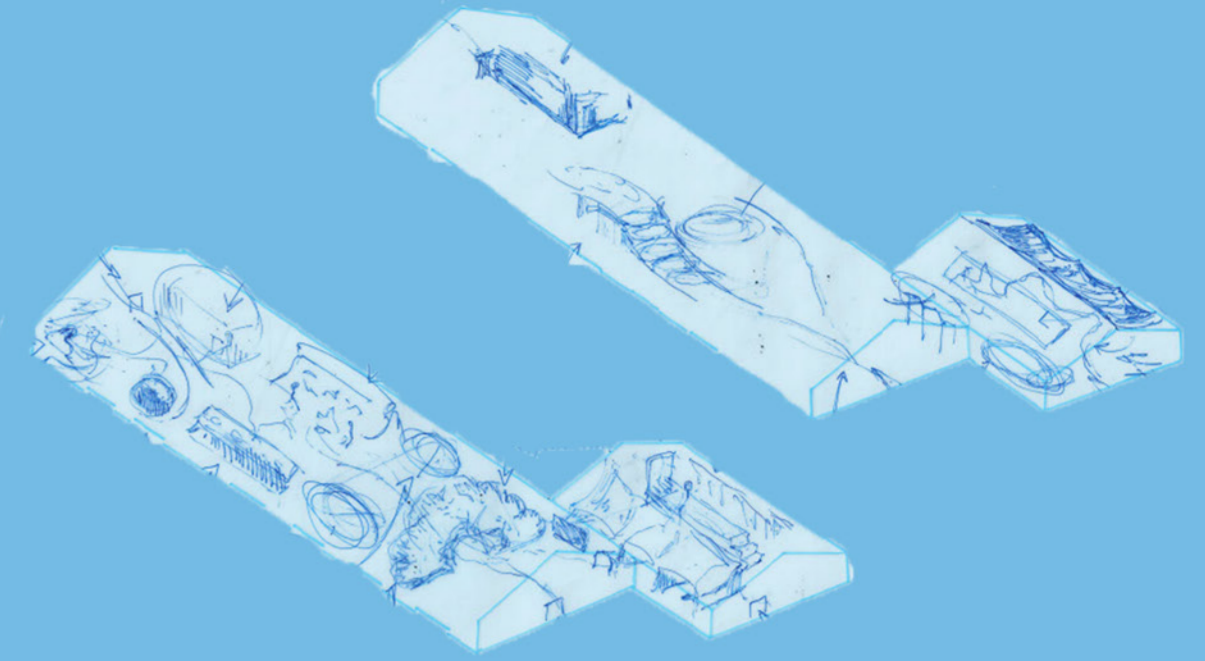

i took the answers i used in my design and created a nostalgic yearbook, their house designs were created into a big house of inspiration of further development.

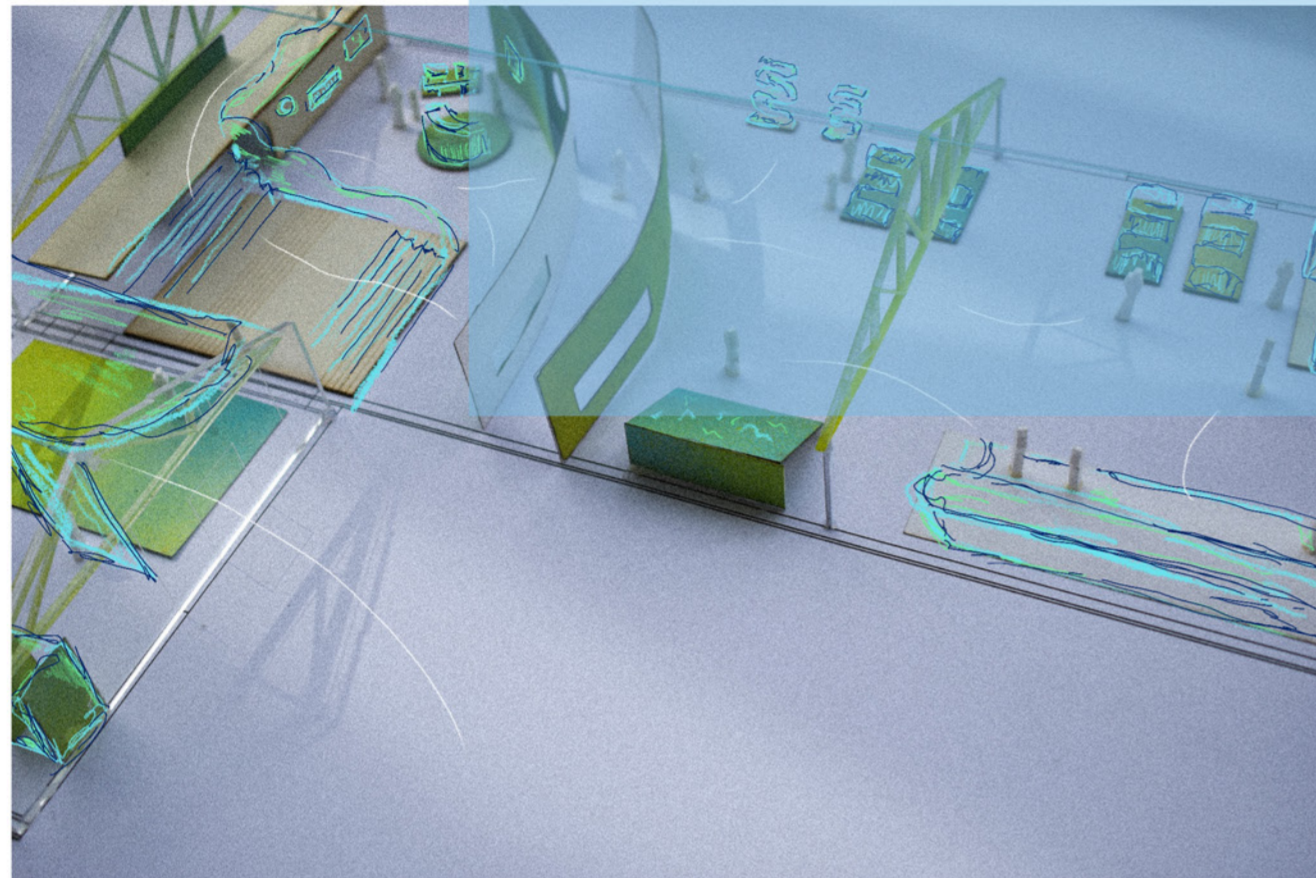

playing about with scale and play by turning lego into dolls house windows, creating familiar and playful structures.

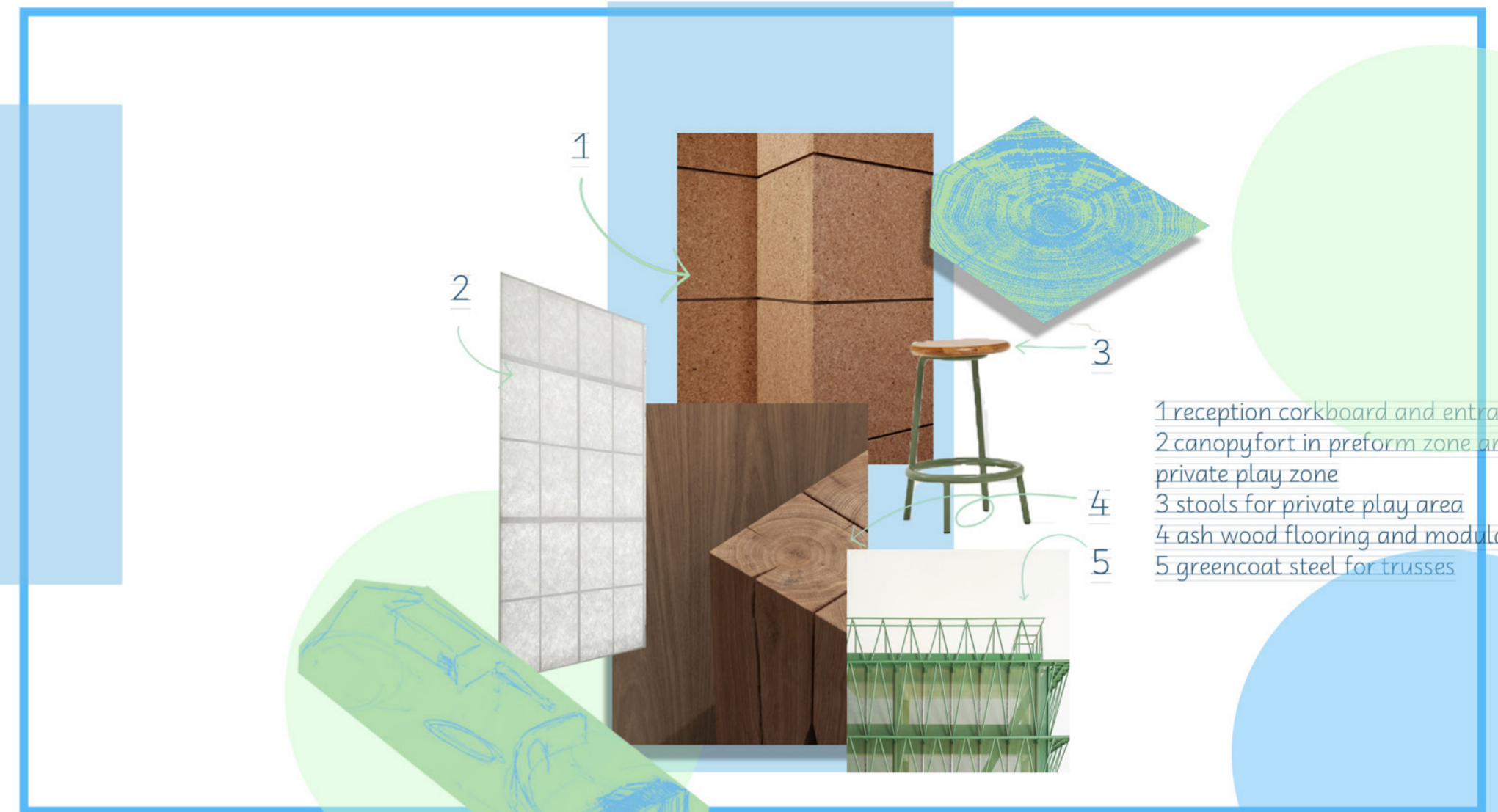

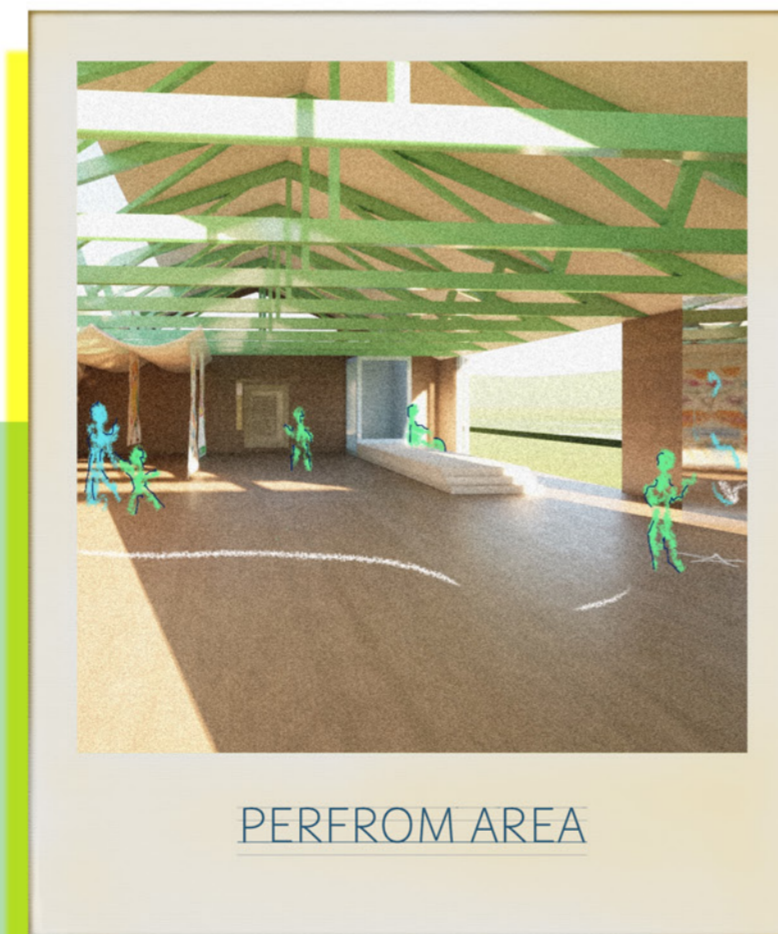

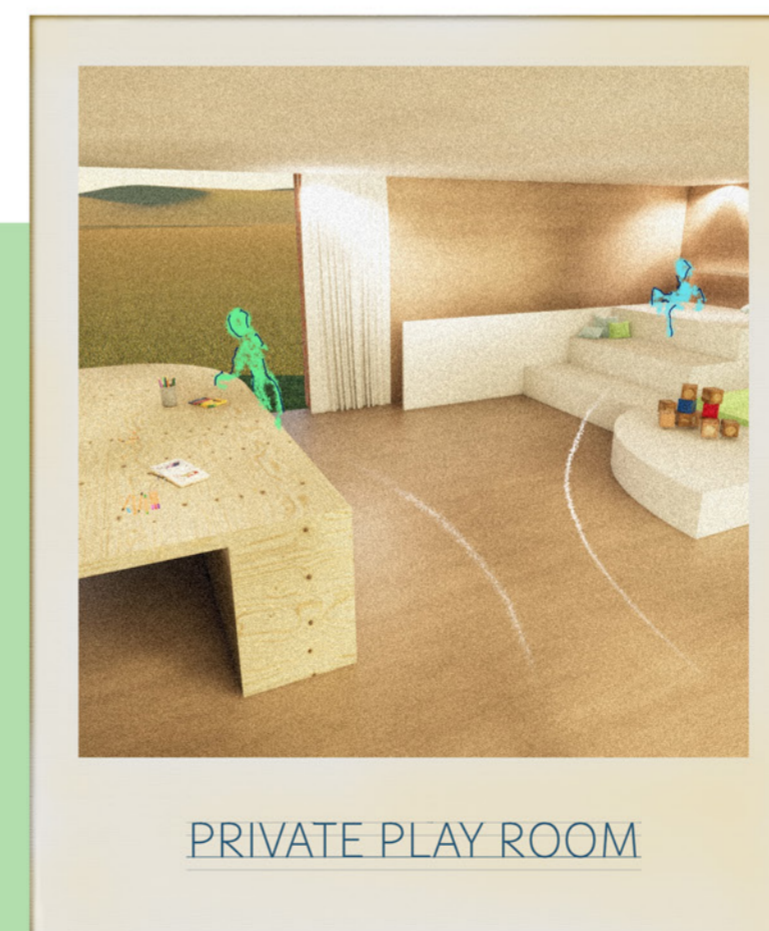

- 5 greencoat steel for trusses



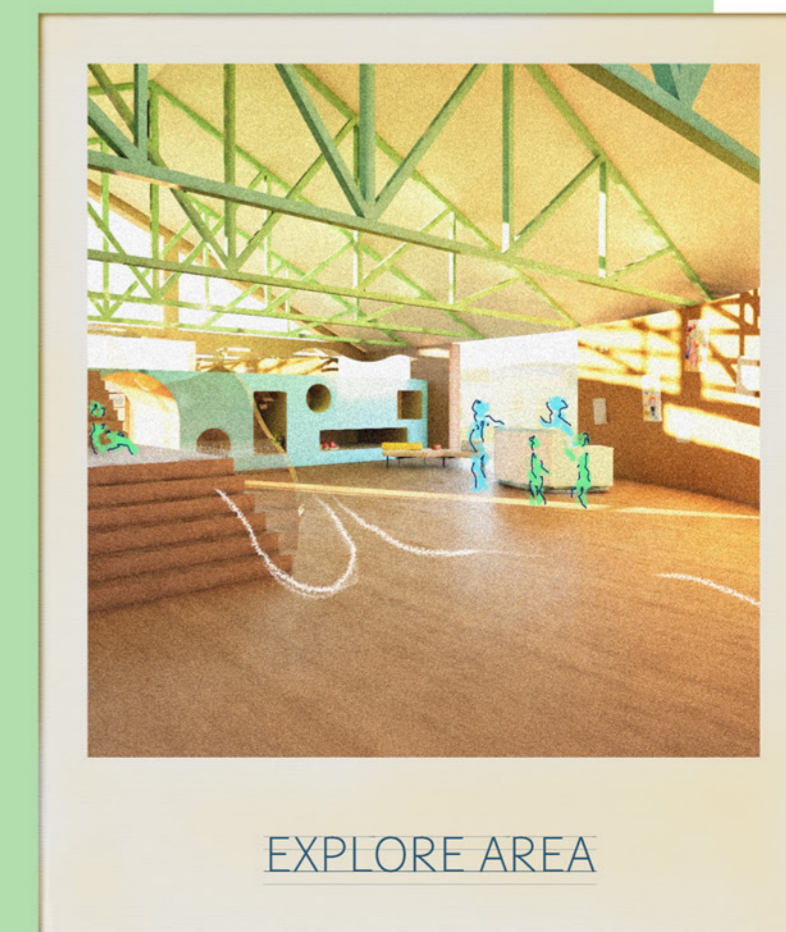
