Brief investigates hedonism on the seafront. A very unique sea-side site in Sliema, Malta. The brief is to design a Beach Club, a space for escapism and enjoyment.

Creating a contrast between the basement nightclub's darker, moody aesthetic, catering to adults seeking an immersive nightlife experience, and the lighter, cheerful ambiance of the sustainable restaurant and bar on the upper floors, designed for both adults and children to enjoy together.

Also, the physical contrast between the levels of the building serves as a metaphor for the varying moods and experiences offered within the space. The nightclub represents a hidden, exclusive retreat for nighttime revelry, while the elevated restaurant and bar symbolize a communal gathering place infused with warmth and sustainability.

















