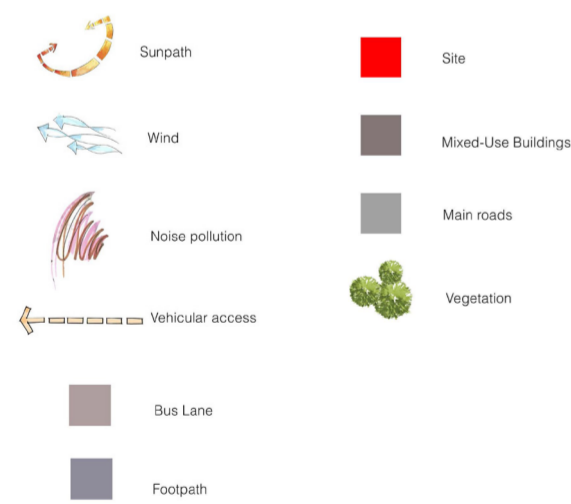

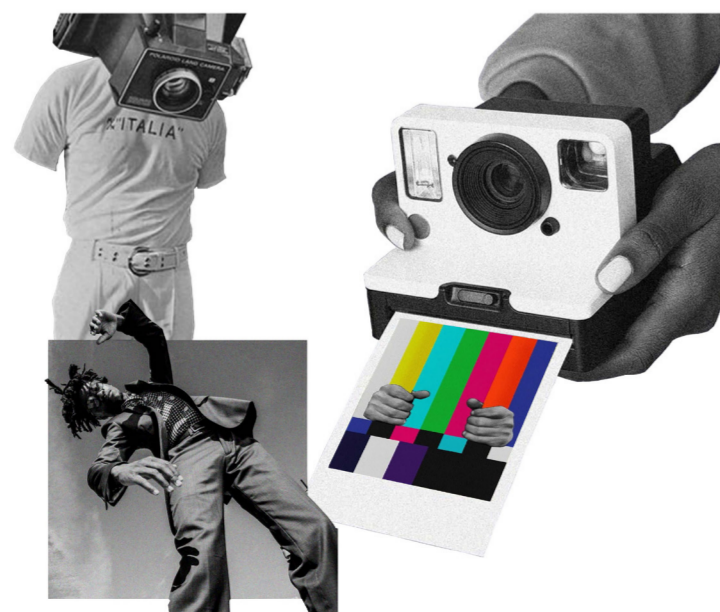

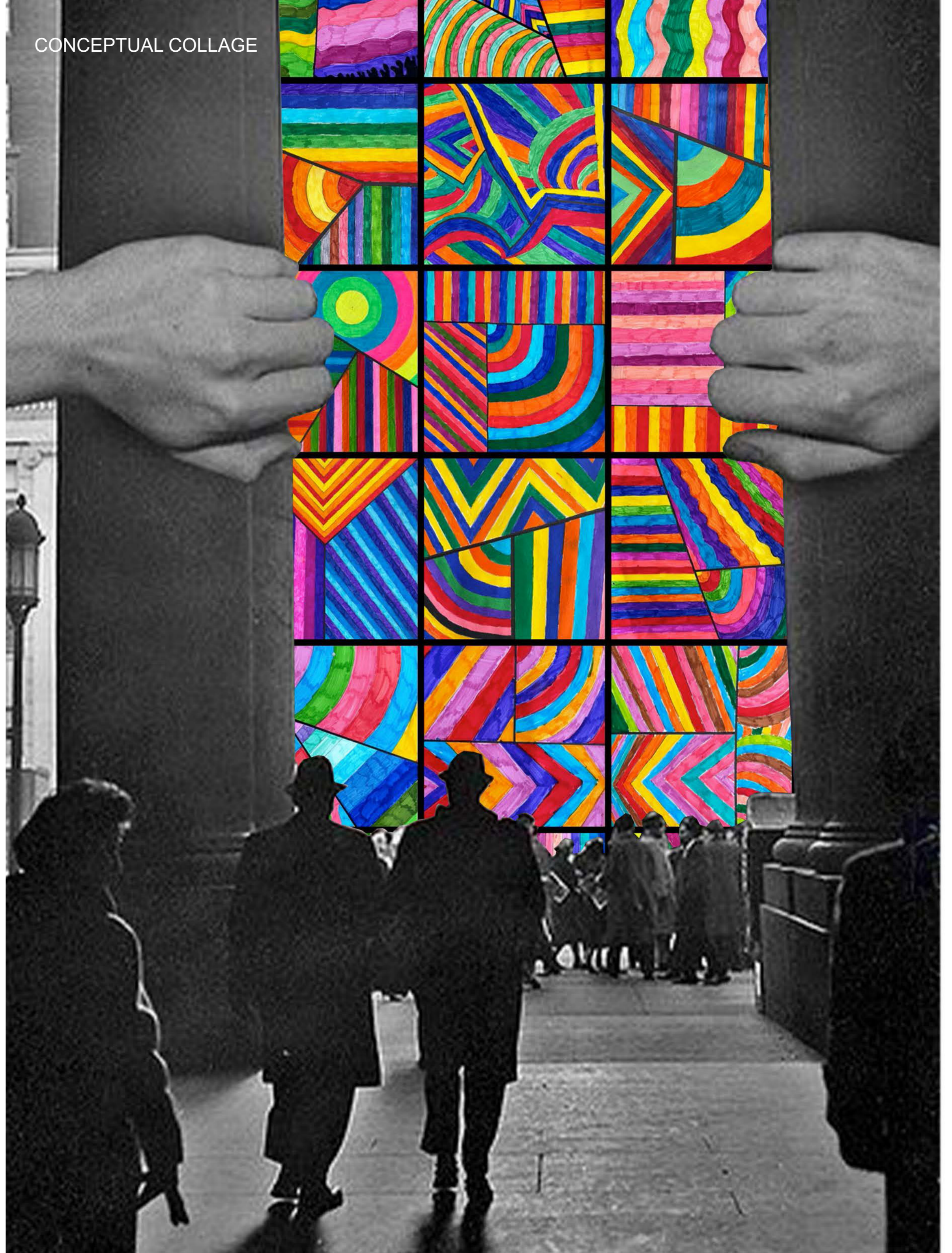
This site is a gap site between two Victorian houses where we were tasked with creating an inclusive and socially diverse gallery and artists residency.

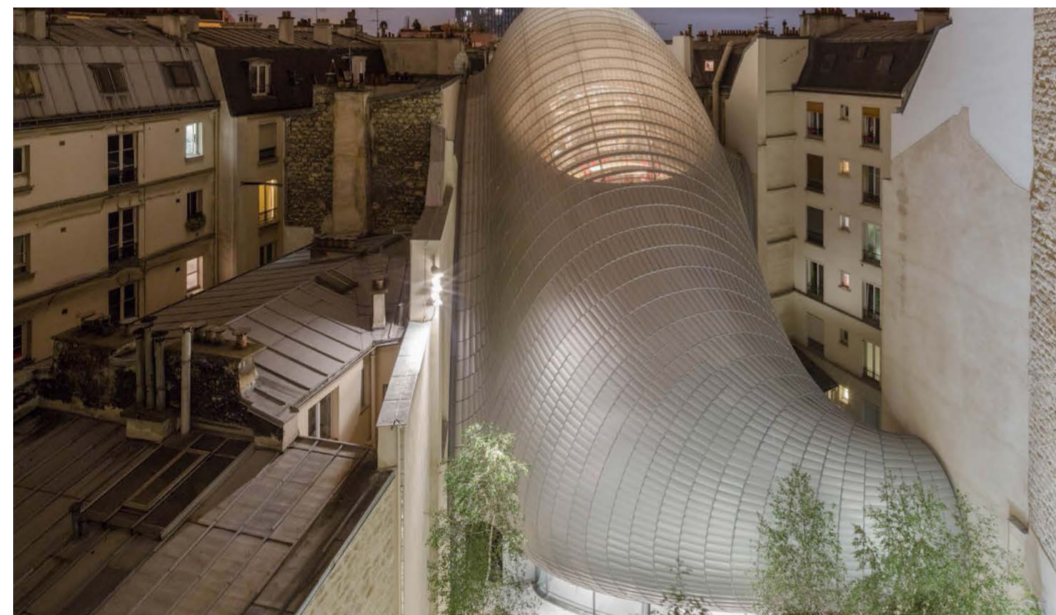

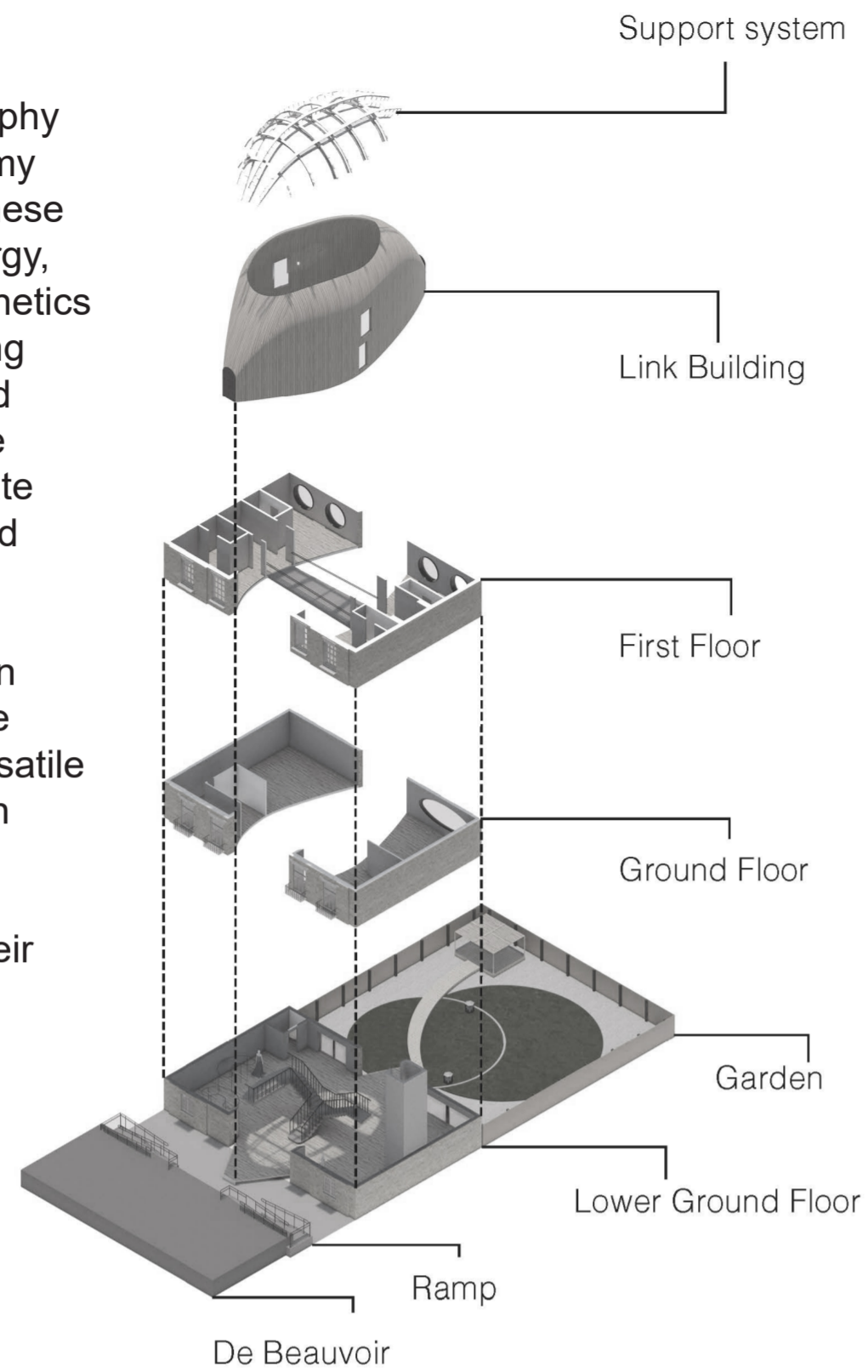

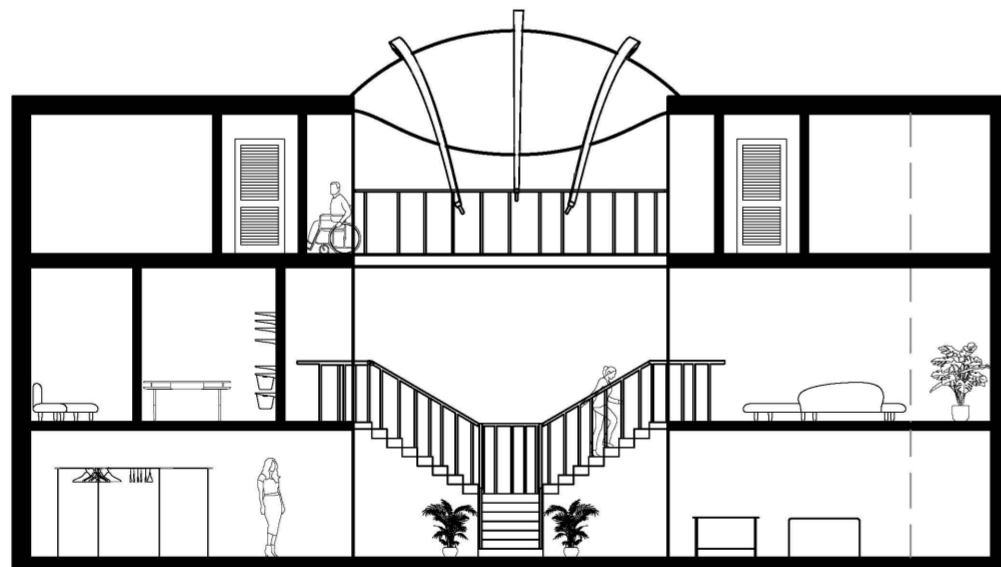


## THE BIG IDEA

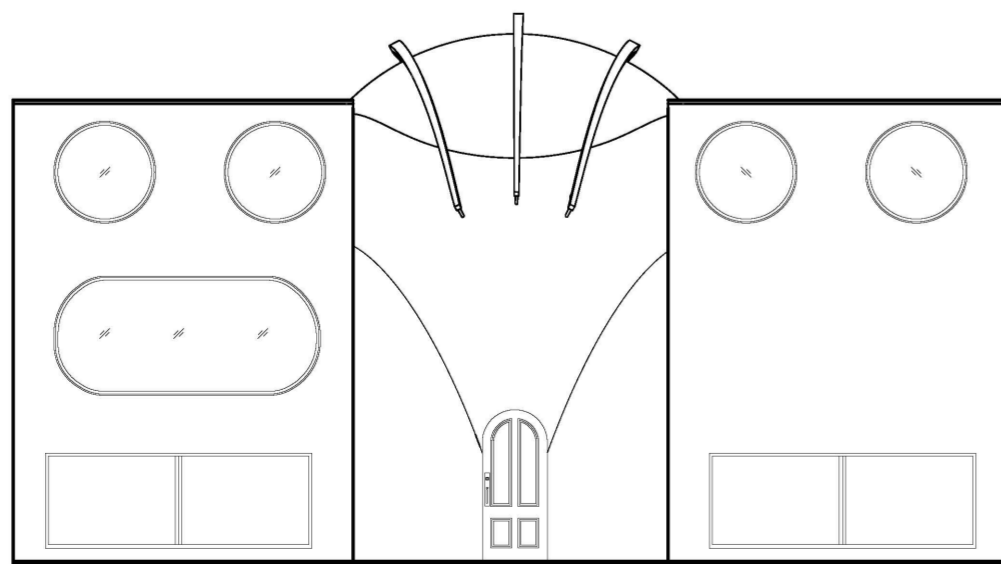

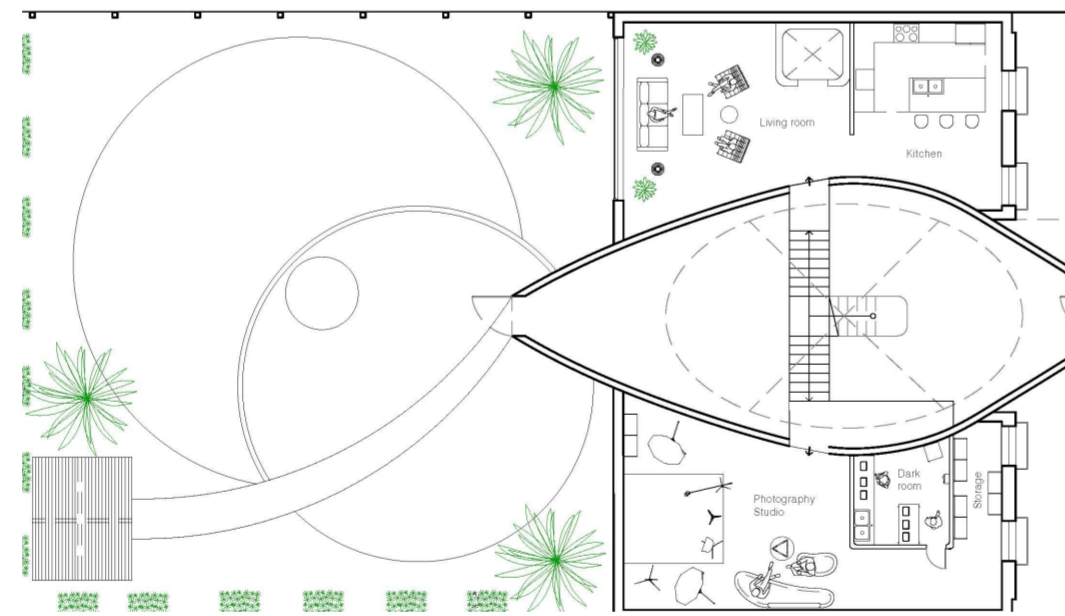

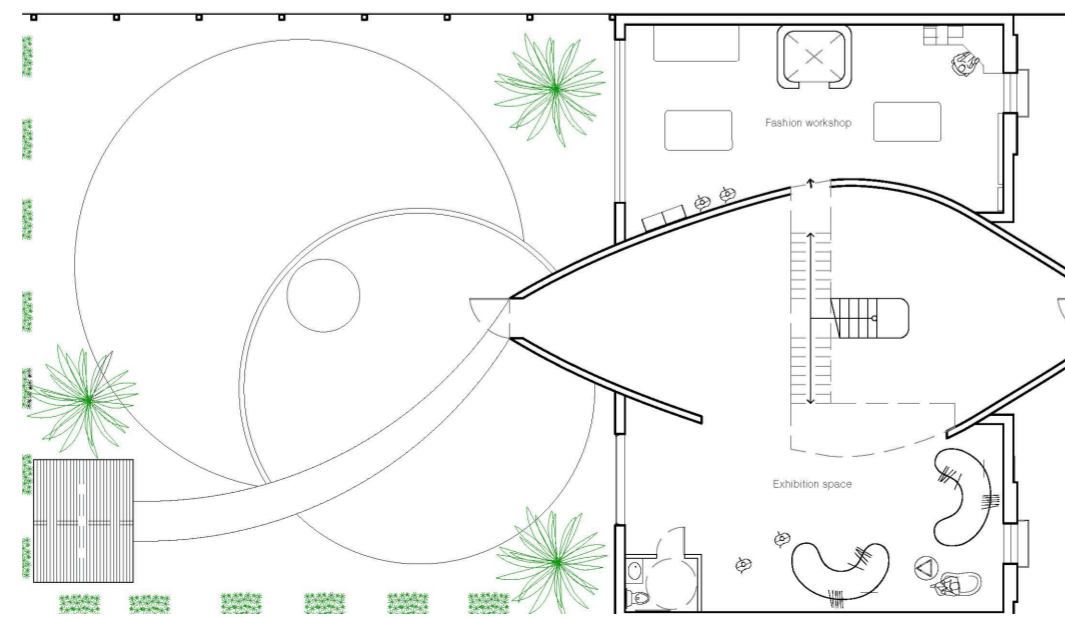
SECOND FLOOR PLAN

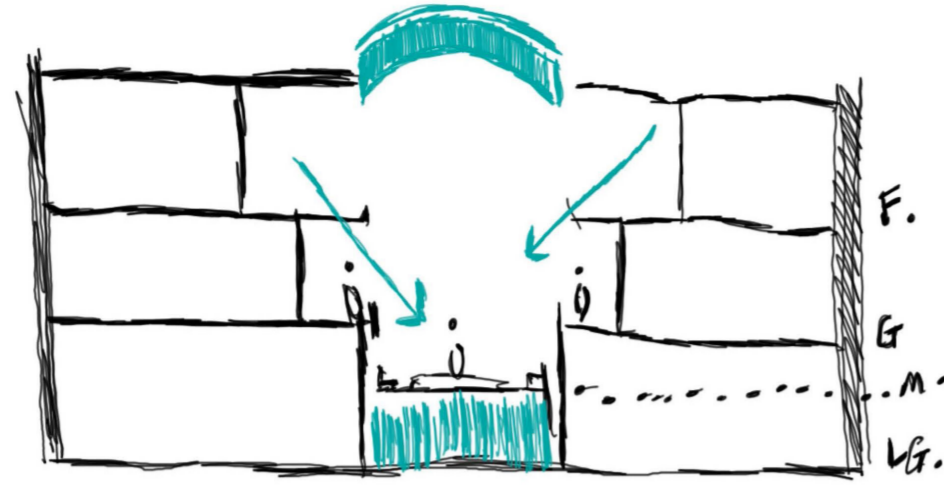

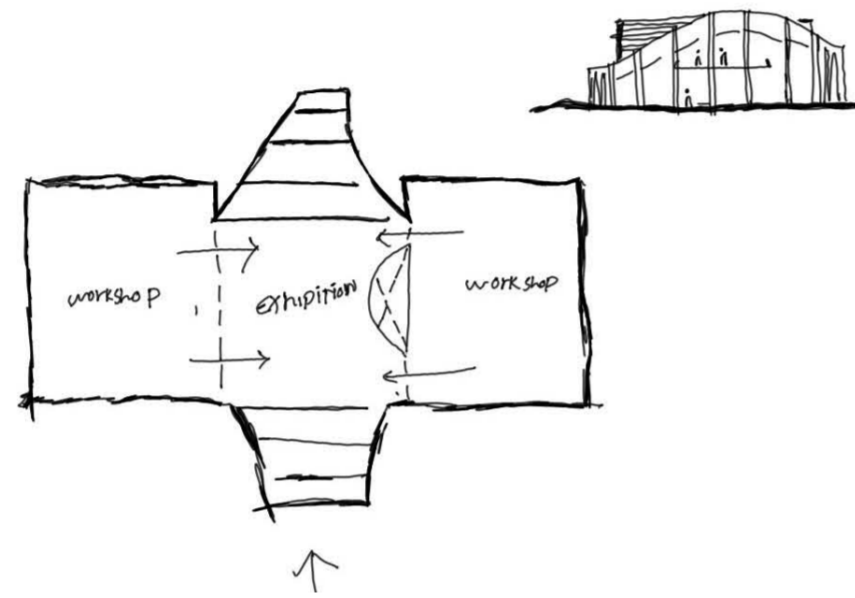

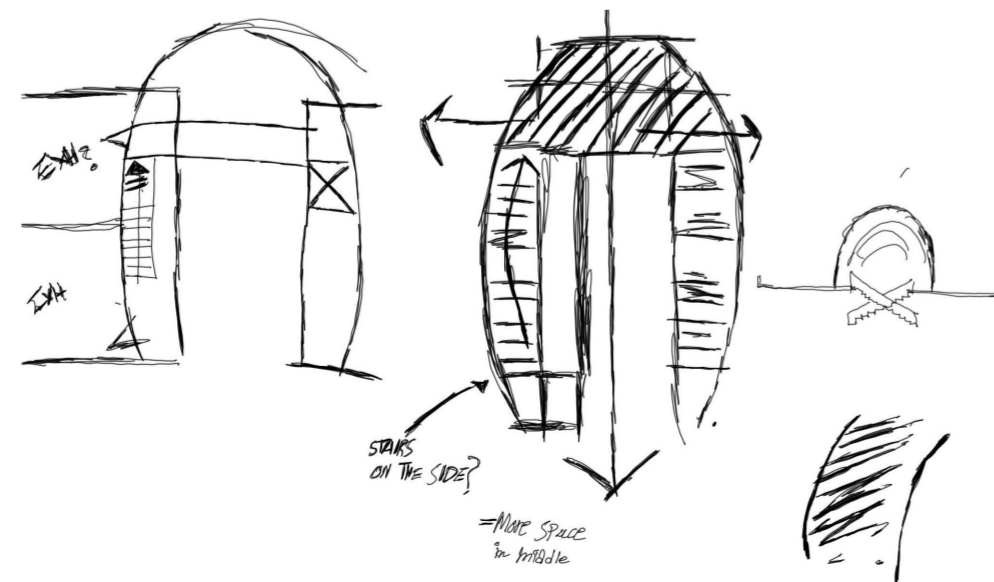
