# FASHER Dyeing & Repair

Dyeing to Repair is a workshop experience store funded by a sustainable textiles advocate, 'Fashion for Good'. The store is a visible mending experience that encourages the unique and creative repair, of textiles in a sustainable, innovative way. Unlike traditional methods of repair, Dyeing to Repair utilises a blend of traditional and innovative methods to engage and excite a younger generation. This project seeks to provide a space in which users wanting to repair their well-loved clothes can 'Design' and visualise their outcome using AR technology; 'Salvage' materials from the local area to enhance their repair; 'Dye' their own embroidery threads using a sustainable water-less digital dyeing system and finally carry out their repair in the 'Flourish' workshop. Users will leave the experience with a unique, rpaired item of clothing that has been given a new lease on life by its very own wearer.

The design of the space was imformed by the concept of plant growth; Germinate, Absorb and Flourish. This idea became my conceptual approach in which I've used to create a design that has a sense of movement and growth.

**Germinate** - AR designing to reimagine the possibilities for creative repair Germinate, absorb & flourish; areas were generated through plant analogy which was inspired by the idea of visible mending, in which, utilised forms found in nature

**Flourish** - Mending workshop in which users will carry out their repair with staff and digital assistance

Visible mending -Expressing the damage in a unique, honest way

**Absorb** - Collect salvage materials and dye your own threads for stitching using twine solutions waterless dying and learn about the importance of water preservation (WWF)
