

Cultural Exchange Brief







No. 9 Fargate is a detached 4 storey narrow building, with an easy public access and a great potential to develop the proposed brief into immersive place for people.































Proposed Stair Technical Drawing



Stair Detailed Drawing Scale - 1:10 - 1:25 + 3D visuals






Balustrade Detailed Drawing Scale - 1:5 - 1:10 - 1:20 - 1:25 + 3D visuals
