

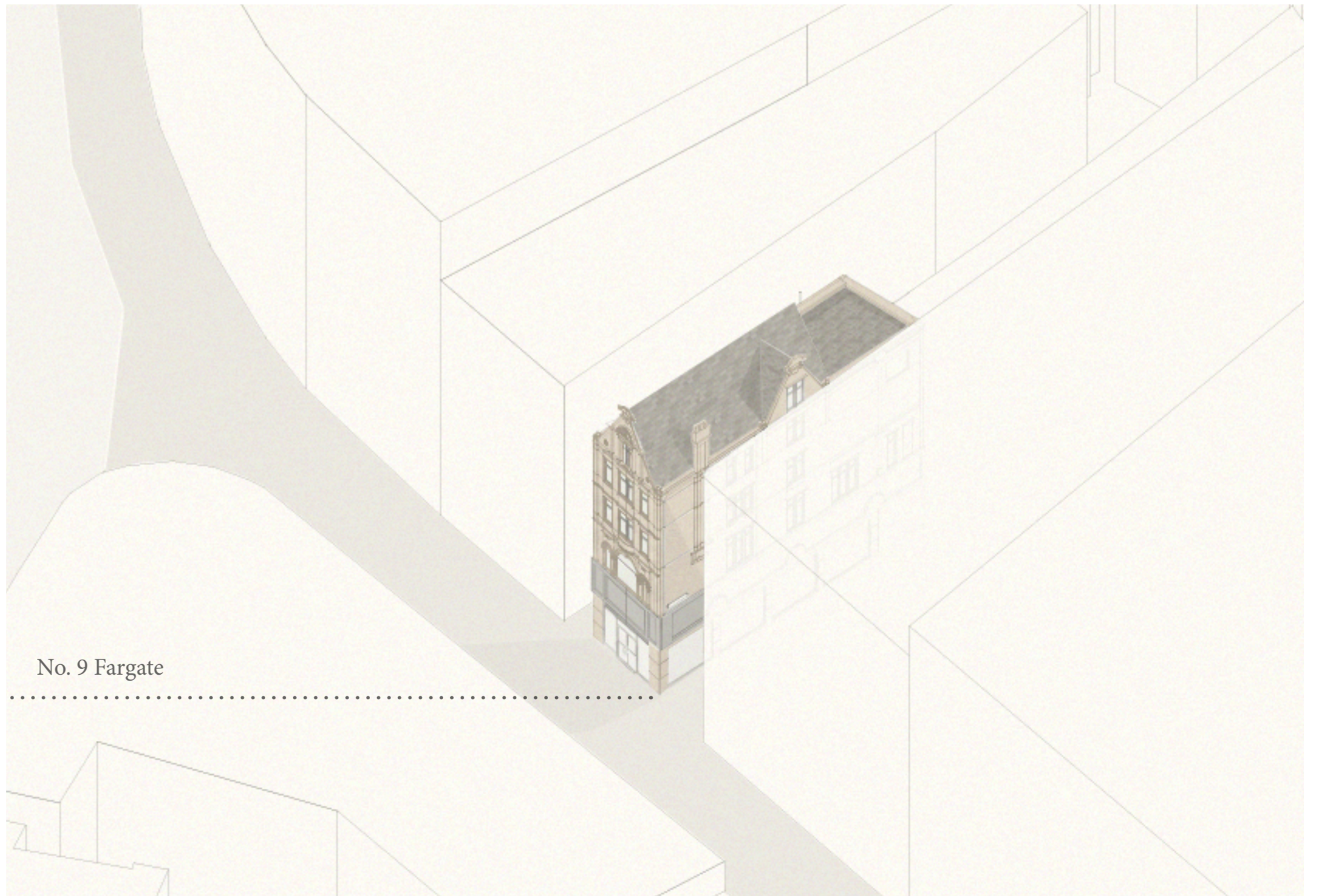


#### Cultural Exchange Brief

No. 9 Fargate is a detached 4 storey narrow building, with an easy public access and a great potential to develop the proposed brief into immersive place for people.

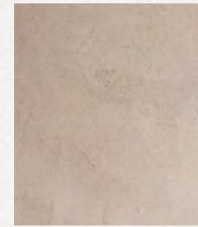




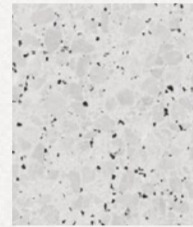
Atmospheric feel of the space - bringing Baltic Sea colours and mood to the proposed interior design



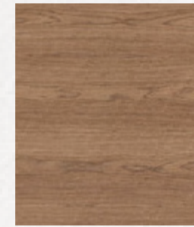

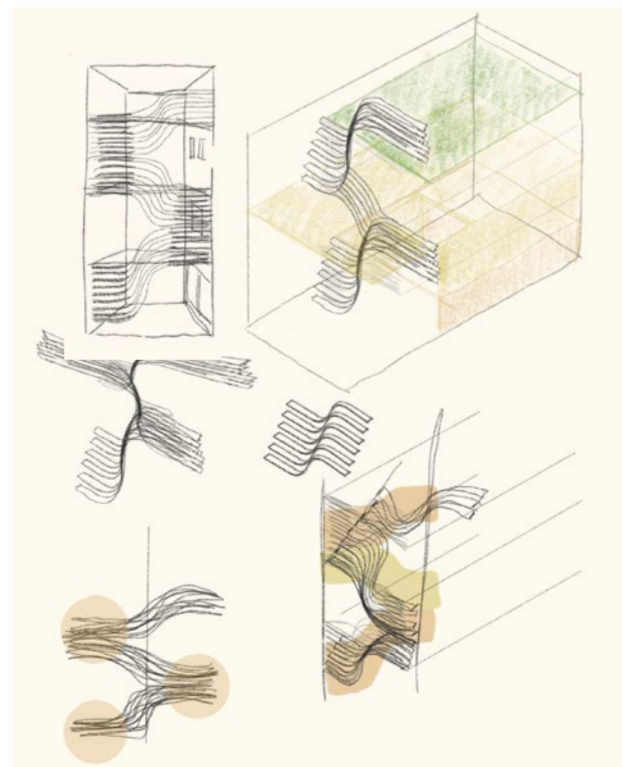
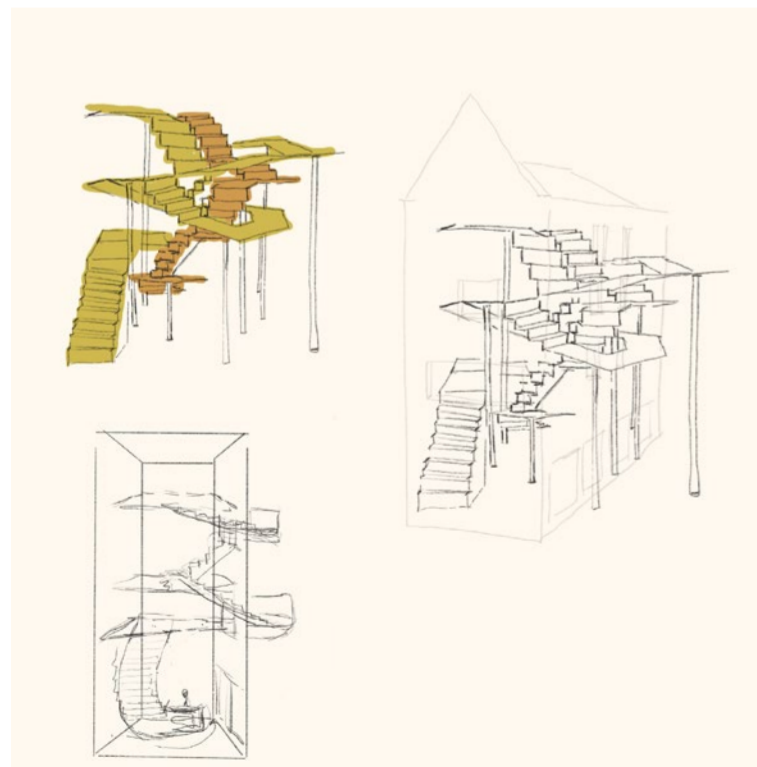

Atmospheric feel of the space - colour palette extracted from Baltic Sea key images to create a mood





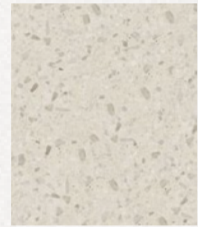
Atmospheric feel of the space - creating interior design inspired by the sea side colours and textures



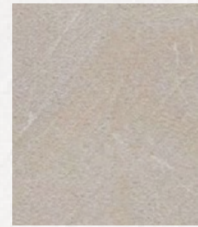

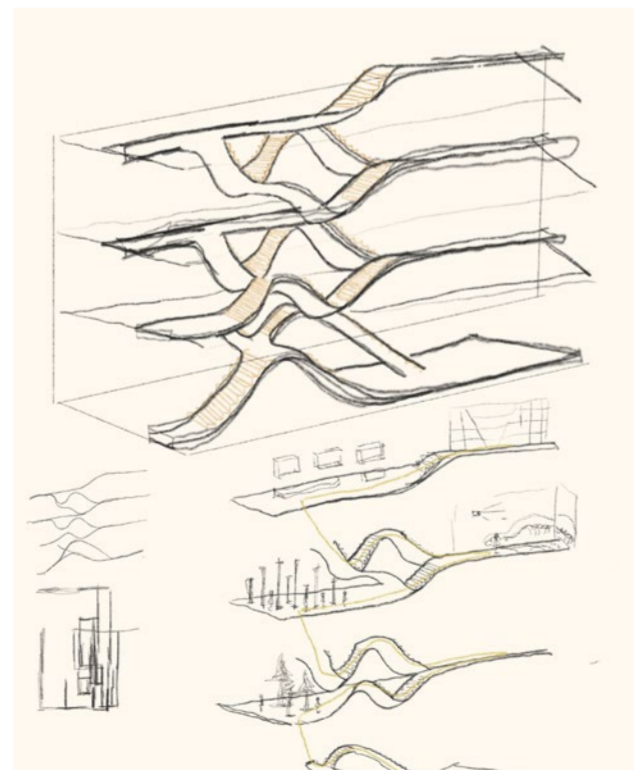

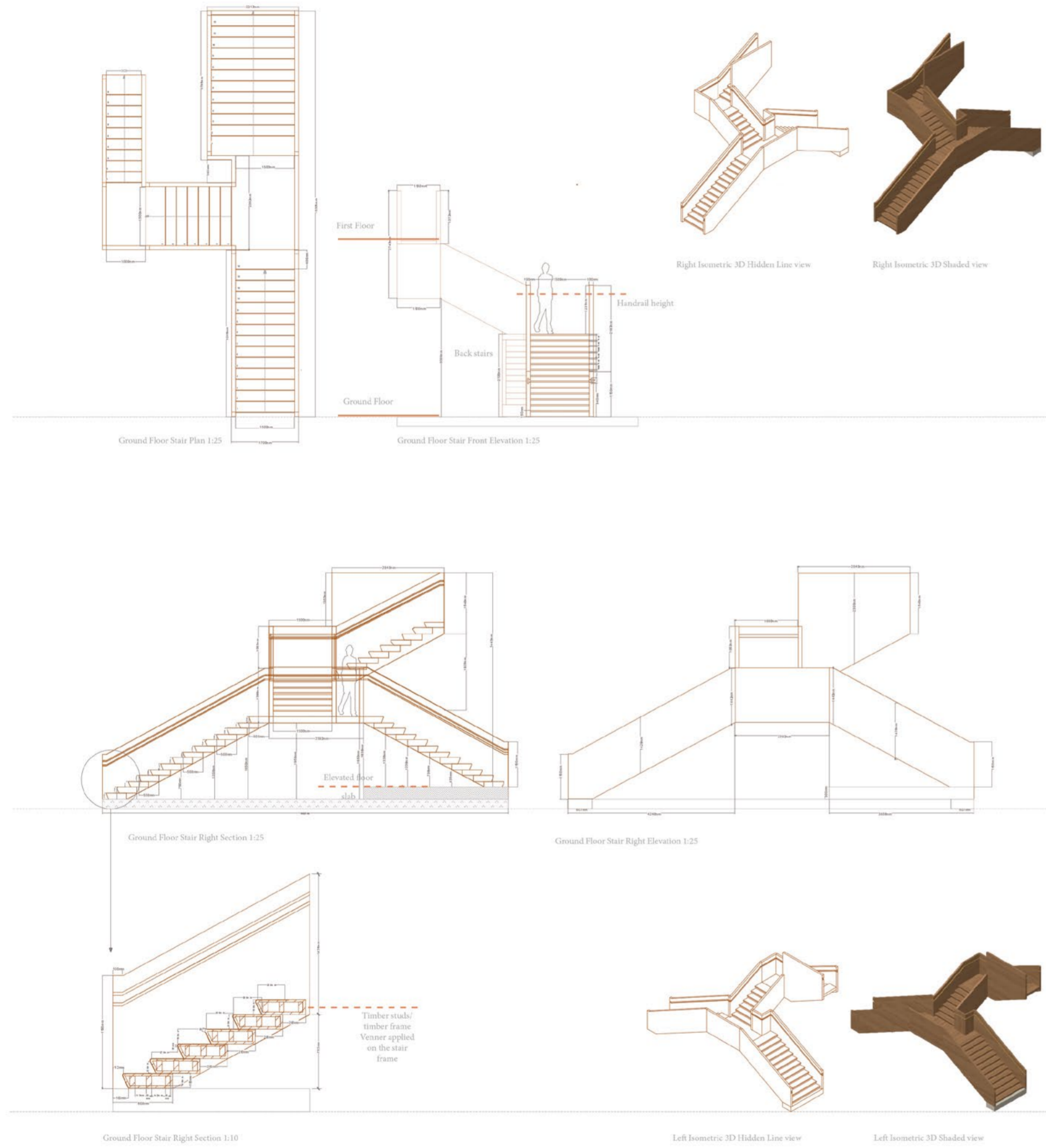


Atmospheric feel of the space - different types of Amber gemstone - raw - polished - fossilised

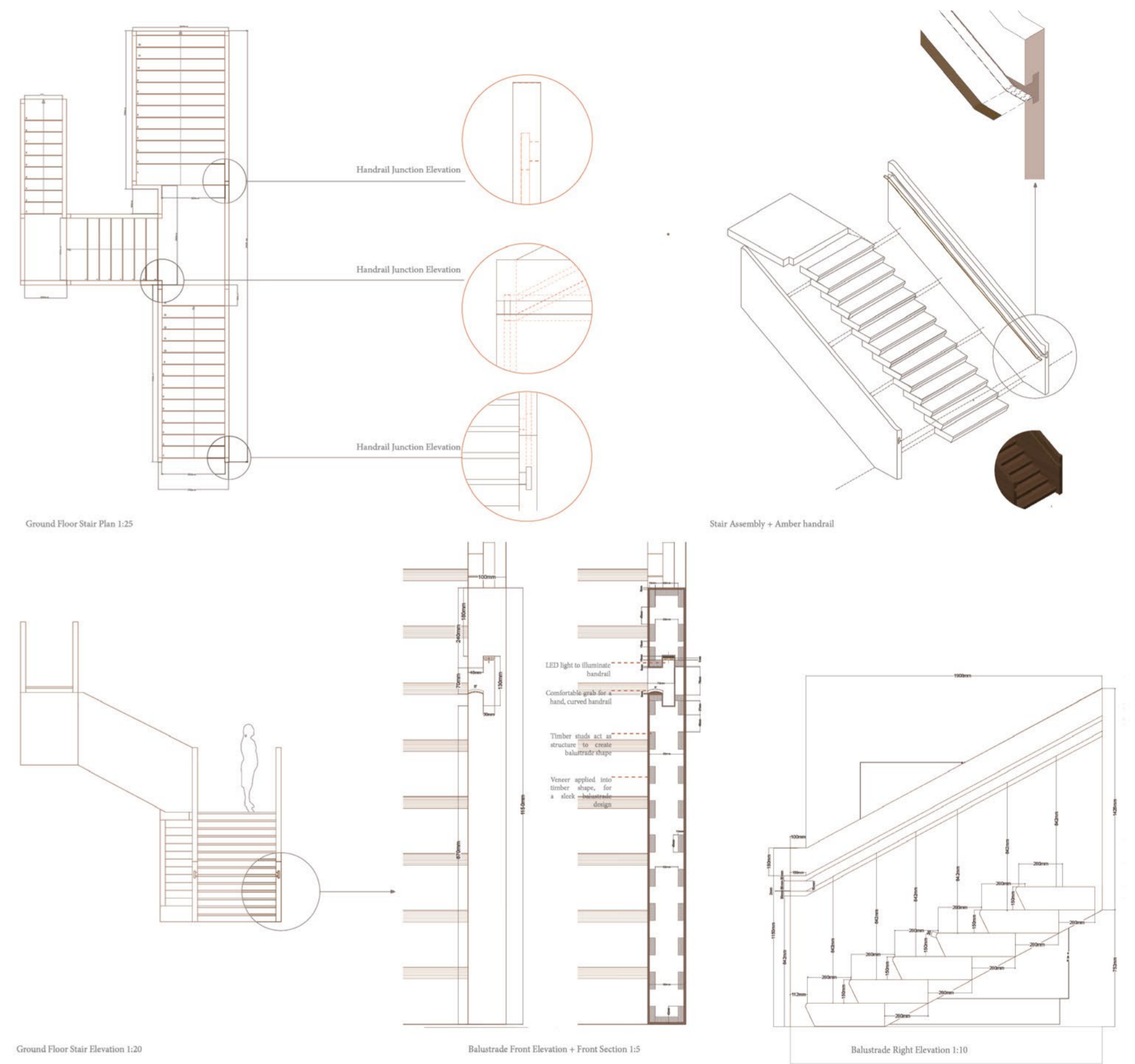




Stair Detailed Drawing Scale - 1:10 - 1:25 + 3D visuals
