There are countless global issues which the general public have been informed on for decades, yet we have made little significant progress to improve our future trajectory.


Clearly hearing about global issues like climate change, wealth inequality and technological addiction is not enough to elicit meaningful change.


Because seeing is believing I have designed three versions of a future narrative to show the audience a 'Glimpse of the Future' to visualise what could happen to our world.


Designing these three future scenarios depicting two dystopias and a final utopia to show audiences what world they could be living in if we let the worst, or alternatively best, aspects of our society develop.


ENVIRONMENTAL DESTRUCTION


Environmental Destruction - A future in which we have changed our environment to the point of inhabitability, no one is left to fix the problem and nothing can be done to reverse our mistakes.


Evidence of struggle can be seen within the environment, humanities desperate attempts to push their progress and growth to their bitter end.



Structures tower over human scale, these man made monoliths becoming the very thing that snuffs out the hope of sunlight.








To construct my faux structures I have created a recycled timber frame which will be clad and then painted
