






DIAGRAMING



PROJECT SYNOPSIS

Here at Orizuru users are encouraged to form connections with others. The centre is designed for multiple users but mainly with the children in focus. The design has been focused around the term 'thera-play'. This term Theraplay is a structured form of play therapy supporting parents and children to feel more connected. The aim is to enhance attachment, self-esteem and trust in others. The ground floor acts as a social interactive play ground for all users entering the building.



THE BRIEF

ORIZURU ADOPTION CENTRE:

As a society can we, through design support these vulnerable children?

The ORIZURU adoption centre populates the Former Generator station building in Bristol. Within its walls it now holds a busy Adoption HQ for families, foster parents and vulnerable children across the UK. It's a centre that encourages theraplay, expression and connections.

It's key focus is to create a space that is welcoming, a space that demonstrates a safe environment, provides some degree of privacy but at the same time does not interfere with the staffs needs to monitor the users and their wellbeing.

At the centre users will be encouraged to connect through personalising the environment they are in. This will be through art, furniture and therapy.

"Self Expression" and finding a "Identity" is encouraged at ORIZURU. This gives the users of the centre somewhere they feel safe and can belong too upon their journeys.

"Every child deserves a home and love. Period."




The centre will work closely with all family backgrounds to ensure they get the best **support** for them at their point of need at whatever age or stage.


Learning is an on going process for all parents and especially adoptive parents, so orizuru will be a great place centre to nurture experience so they can develop, grow and achieve.


Events, activities, workshops, and consultations will be held here at orizuru.







DIAGRAM SHOWING THE MAIN INSTALLATION

This diagram shows how the floor scape and birds are technically constructed and bolted to the floor. Made from a timber baton frame the floor scape then has the newly designed material "WOOD-SKIN" on top of the structure.

The WOOD-SKIN creates interesting shapes and facets that the children can climb upon. The facets will also create different shadows on the floor which will be an appealing







HUGE BIRD BREAKING THROUGH FLOORS










AXONOMETRIC











BACK WALL ELEVATION











harmoniously together. I have specifically adapted this colour palette as through research, children who have experienced trauma feel much safer with colours connected to nature.

Fresh hues of green will dominate the space, whilst pops of blues and oranges will contrast against them. The atmosphere should feel calming but playful giving the children an environment they feel comfortable within.














