RE-MODELLING ITALO CALVINO'S PYRRHA

Italo Calvino's Pyrrha is modelled by making paper from scraps, generating a story of a past journey to reveal a present form. Combining discarded receipts and reclaimed paper ignites a new beginning and a start of a new journey. The exterior of the model is a 1:1 scale whereas the interior is 1:150. The contrast in scale represents the broader and encompassing perspective of the audience, while the interior displays a hidden intricate composition. Elements that build what is kown as a city are inspired by the Calvino's text; by weaving his vision, and incorporating my interpretation, a new concept emerges; and the city's narrative continues.
