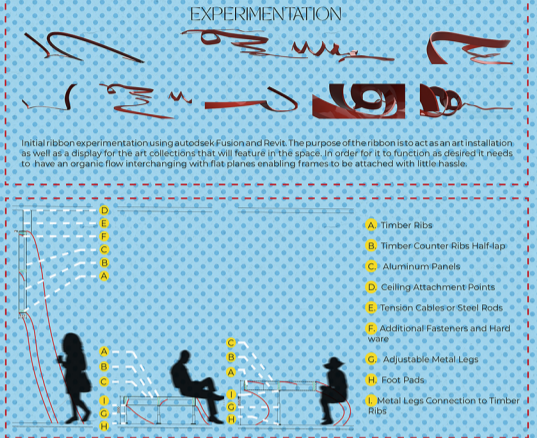
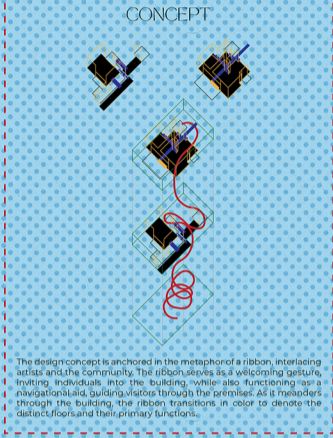

Direct street access and a secondary door which leads to the primary gallery. This cafe allows patrons to sit, work and has a store for resident artists' small merchandise.



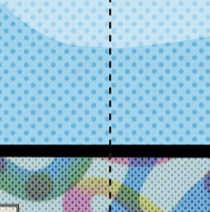
## ART CLASSROOM

Generic art workshops and more specialized classes can be held in these classrooms to allow for different skill levels to participate.



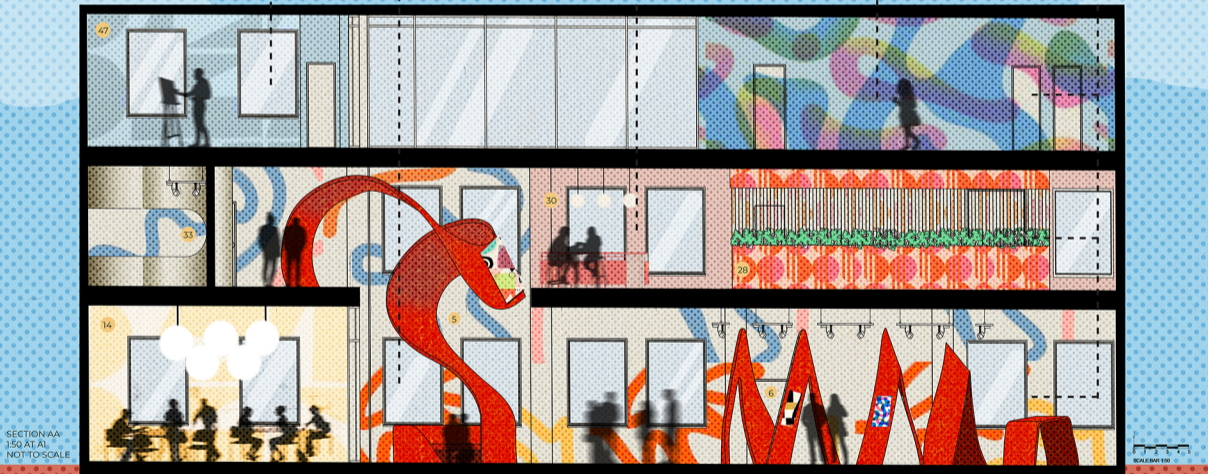
## COMMUNAL AREA

Each of the floors are connected by a central void; this creates visual intrigue drawing people further into the building.



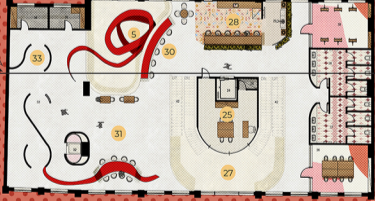

**1st floor: Yellow** - being bright and inviting, is the first colour visitors encounter upon entering, setting a warm and engaging tone.

**Second Floor: Red** - though striking and assertive, is also symbolic of passion and creativity, which is why it is used on the first floor - the hub of teaching and collaboration.

**Third Floor: Blue** - possessing a blend of authority and tranquility, gives resident artists the flexibility to imprint their individuality on the space.
