




## GF ground floor

The ground floor supports lively activities with an open space for community events and a daycare for younger children. As a Wi-Fi-free zone, it encourages face-to-face interaction and active, screen-free play—encouraging parents to engage meaningfully with their children. The entrance and playground are open to the public but close at 10 p.m. for safety.

This space offers a quiet environment for parents, featuring a co-working area with Wi-Fi and computers. A multipurpose room accommodates up to 30 people for meetings or events, while counselling and private rooms provide solitude when available. The floor also includes a daycare for older children and a teachers' room, connected by a staircase.





The entrance are open to the public. Designed with an open indoor concept, the space provides shelter for passersby, as the surrounding area has narrow pavement.

The early-childhood playground is open to the public, offering a space for children to play and interact, especially in the city centre where play areas are scarce. It is designed to encourage physical and sensory activities while ensuring safety and easy maintenance through features like nets and rubber flooring for soft landings.

The lobby and reception also functions as open space for community events.


