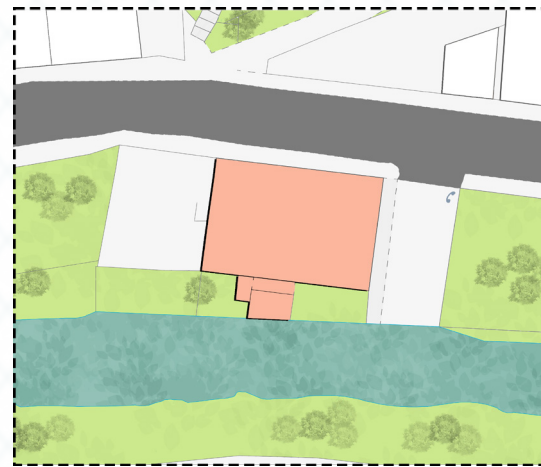
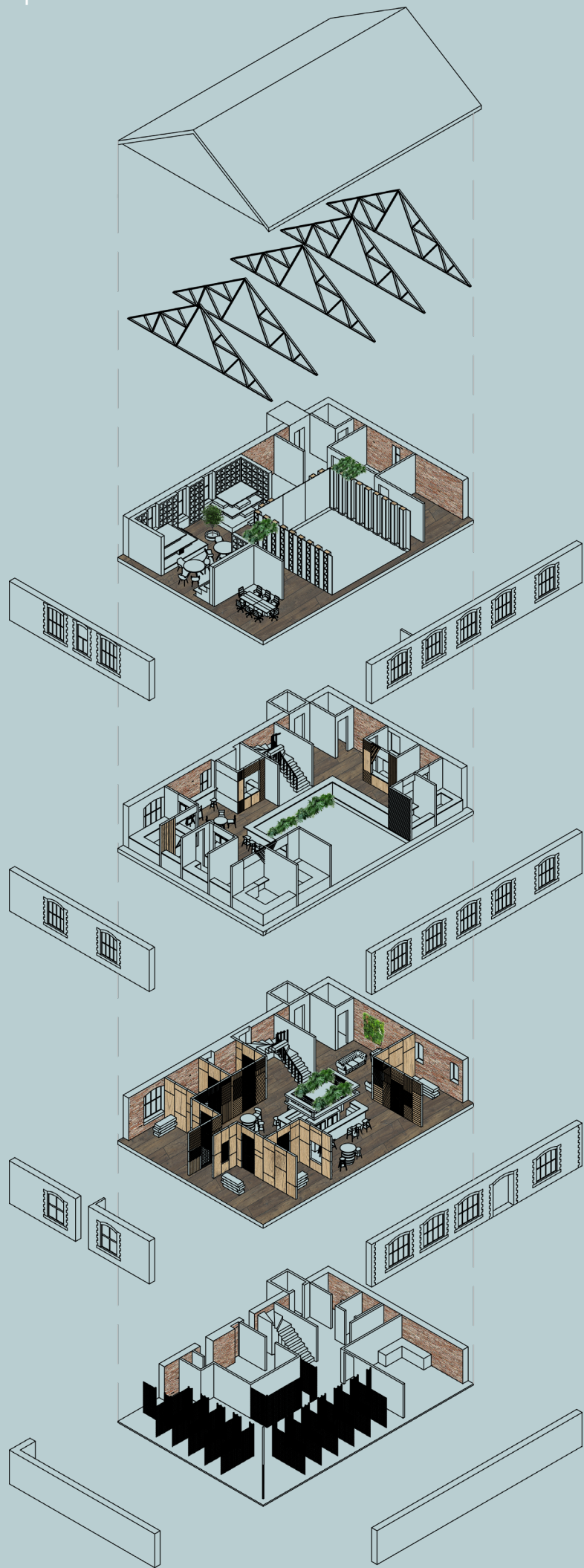

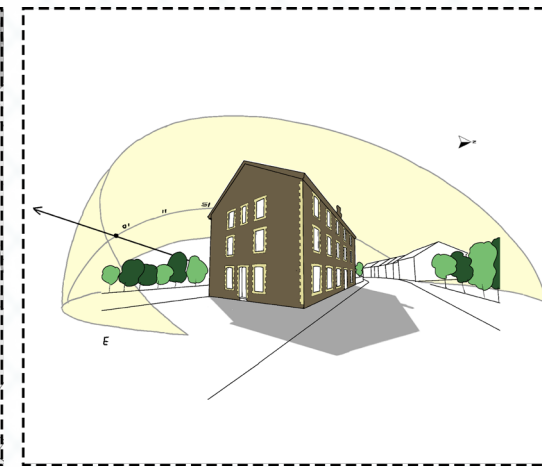
# Exploded Axonometric

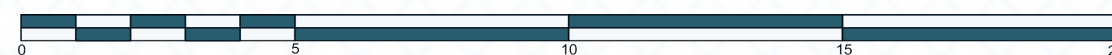
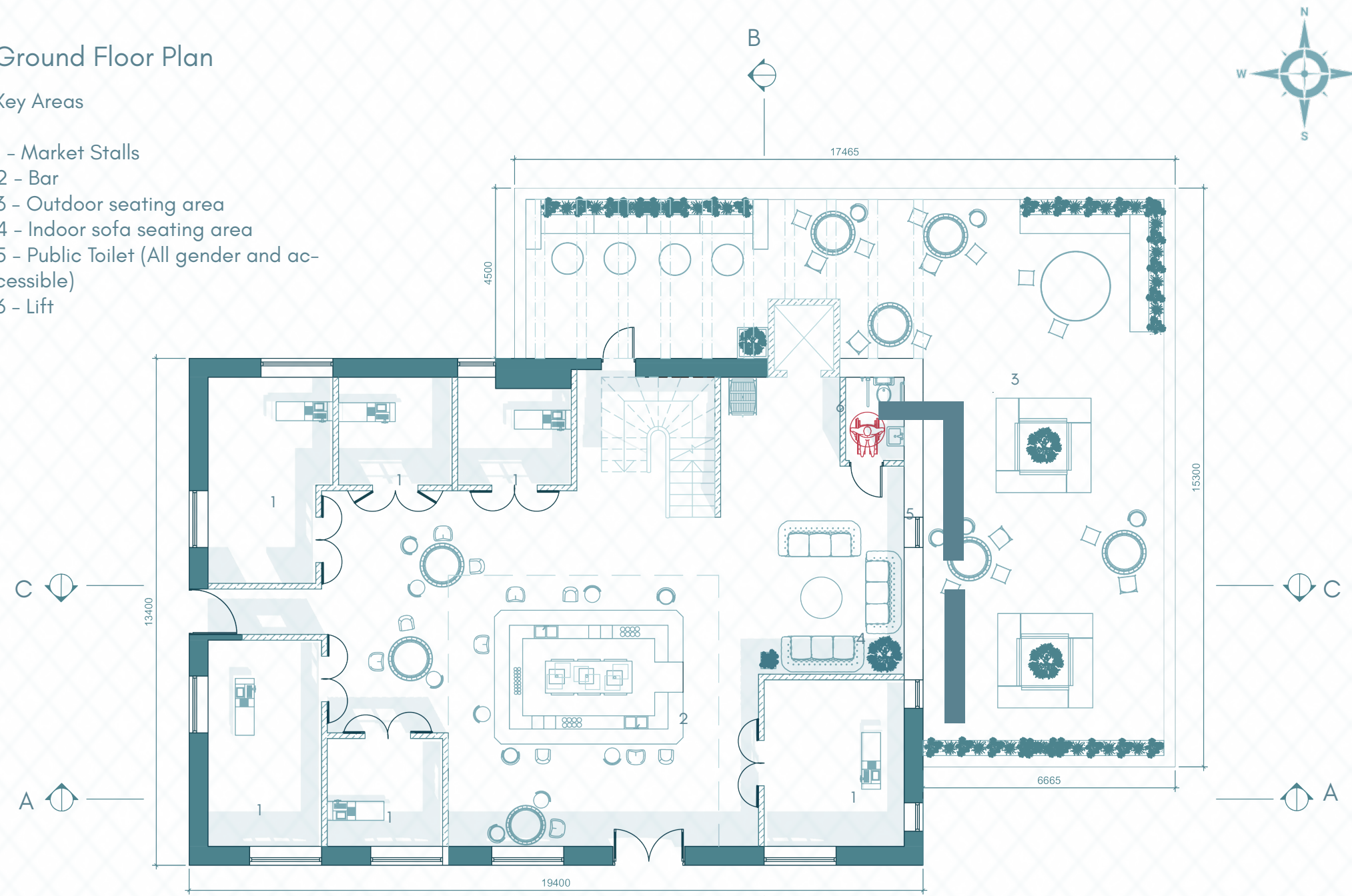

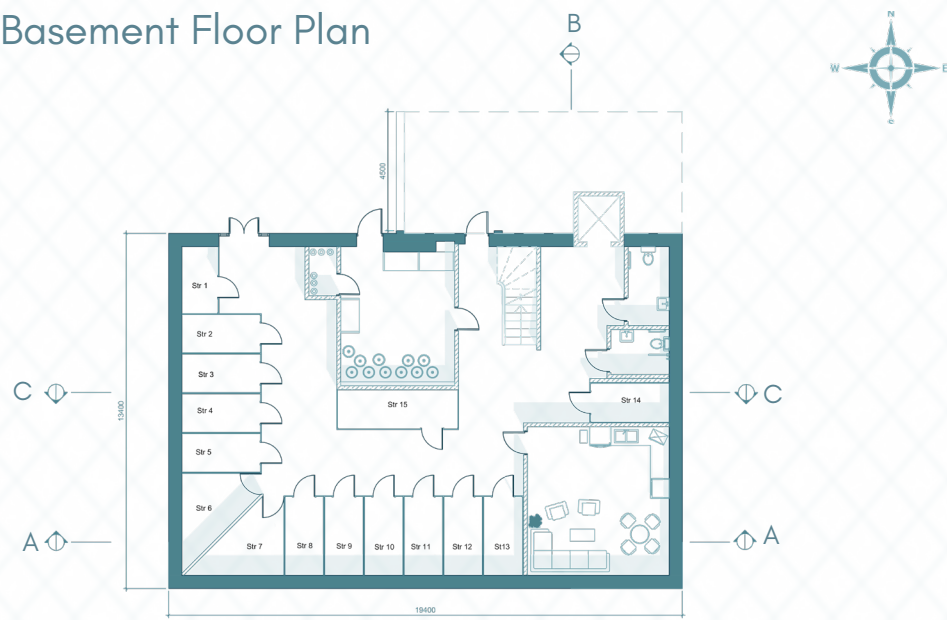
- 1 - Market Stalls

- 6 - Lift



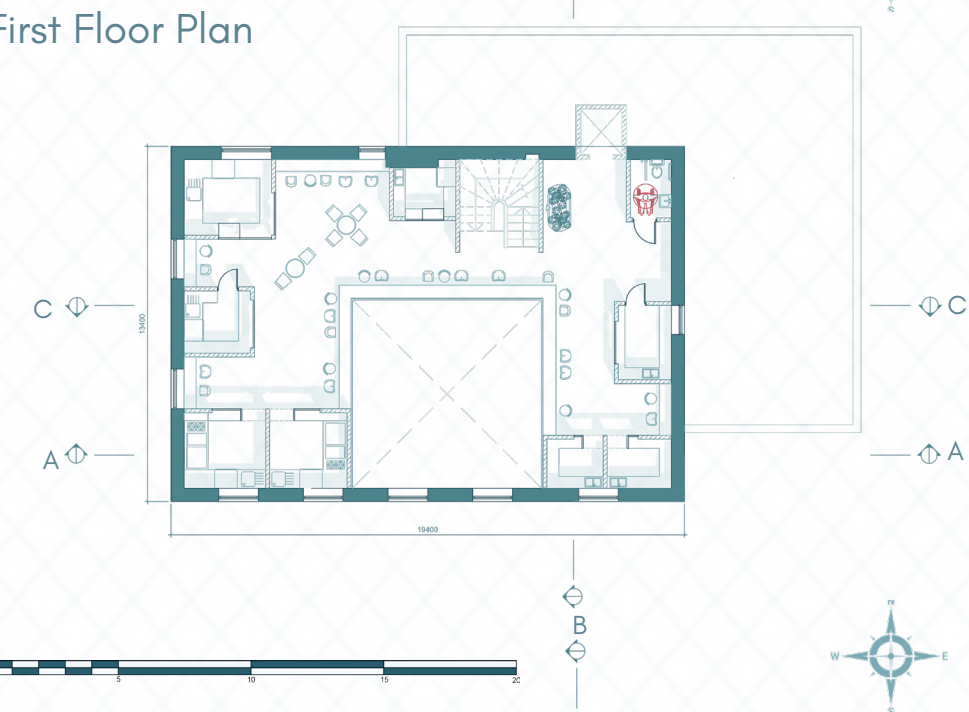

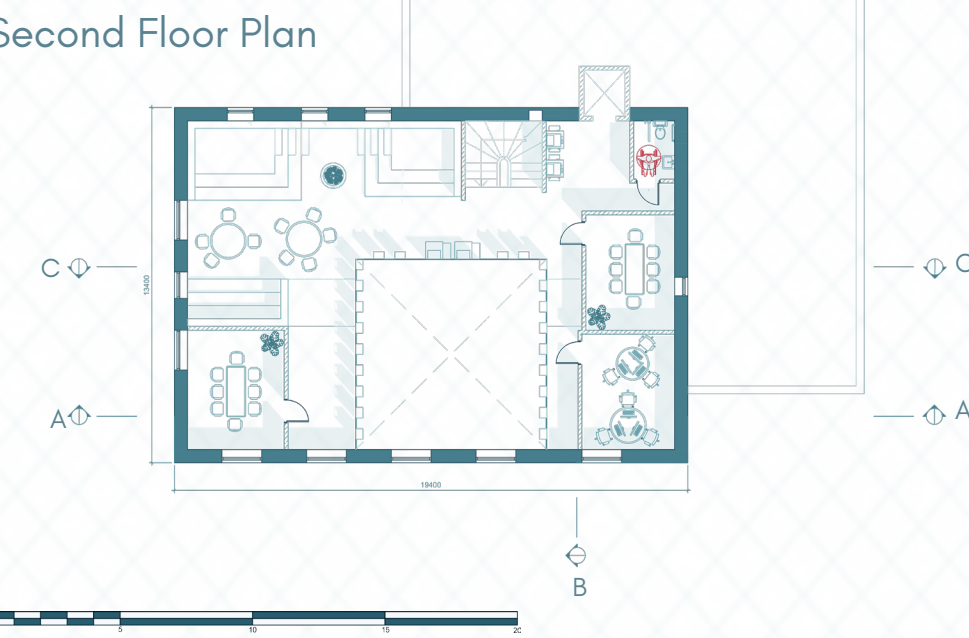
Basement Floor Plan



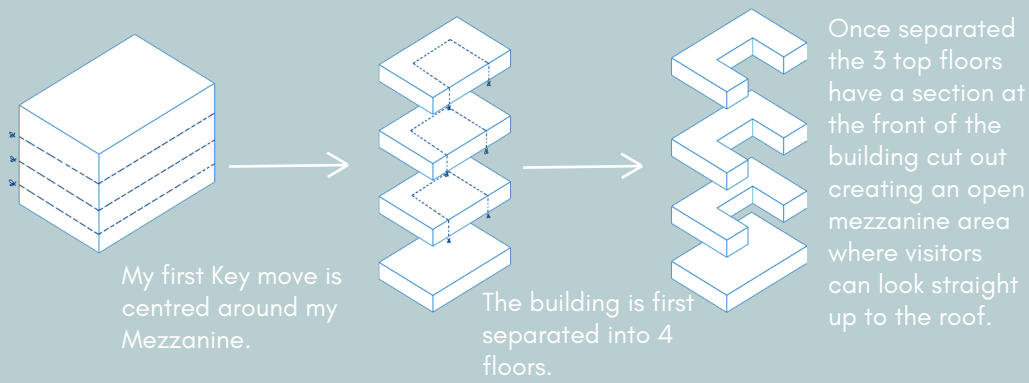
First Floor Plan

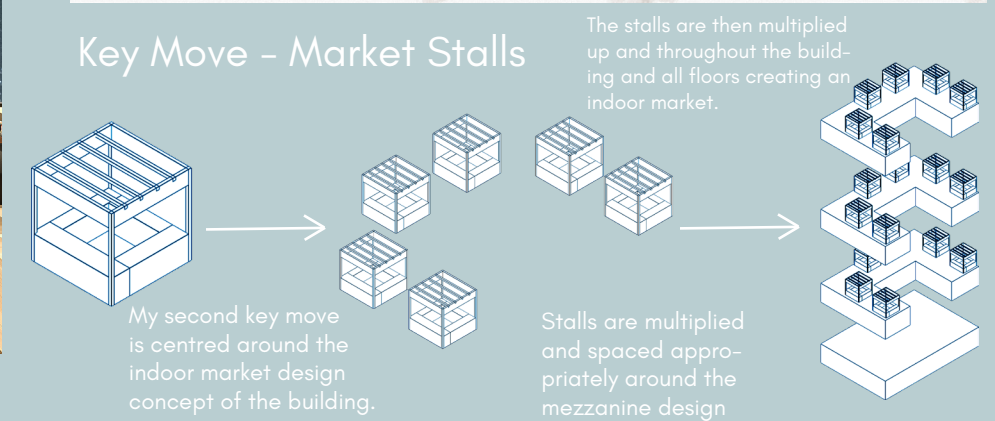

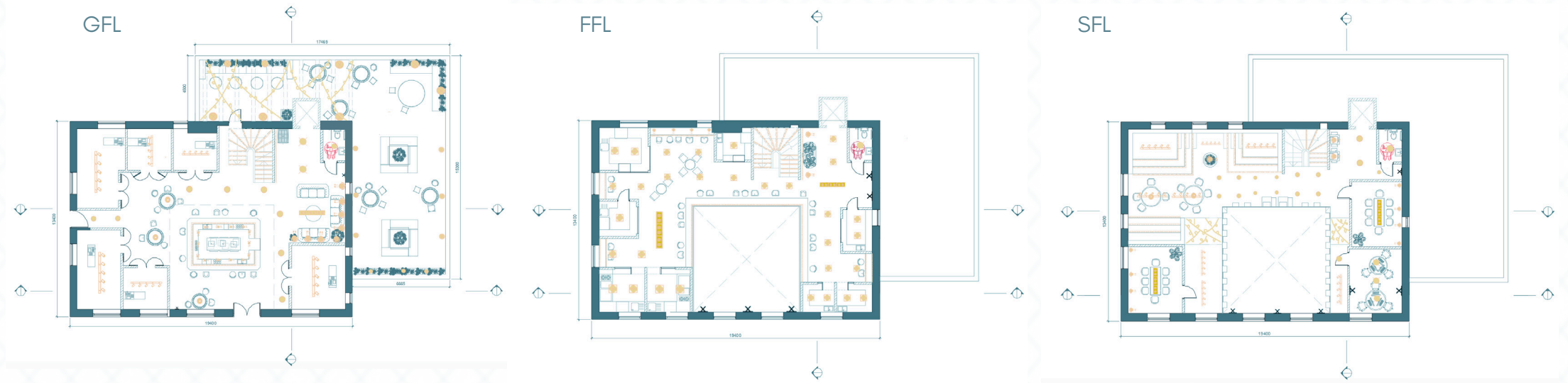

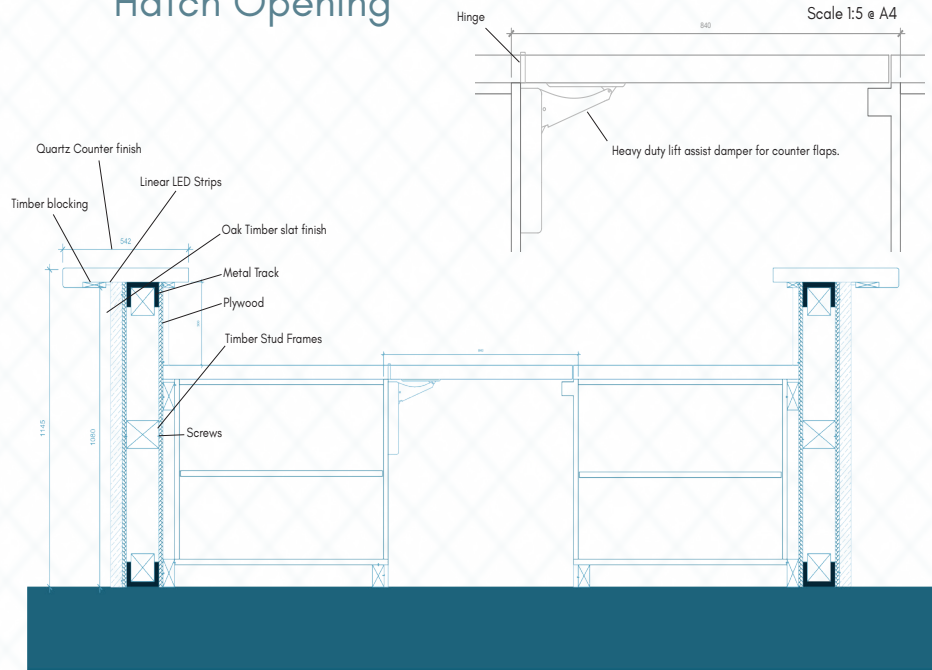

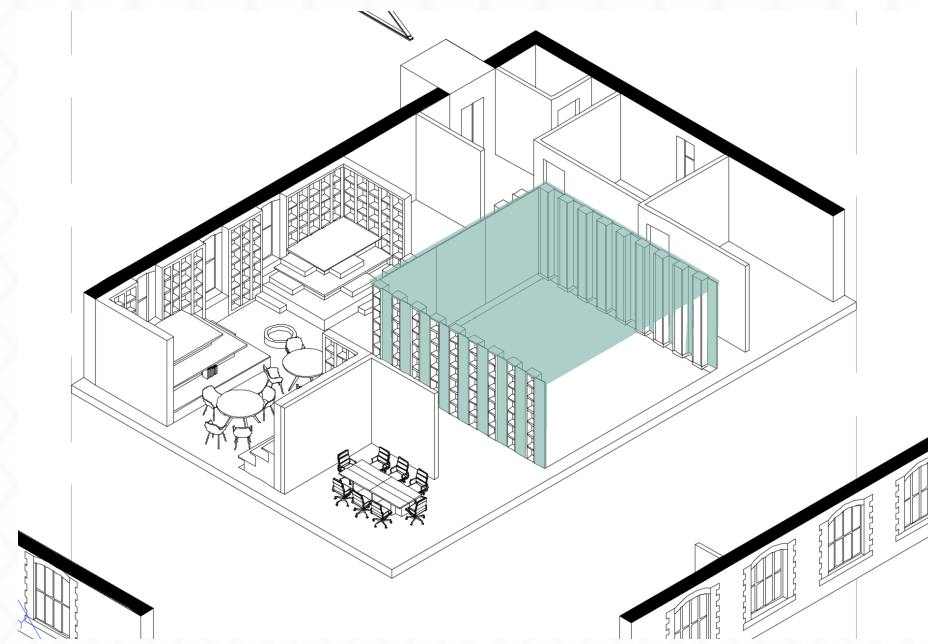

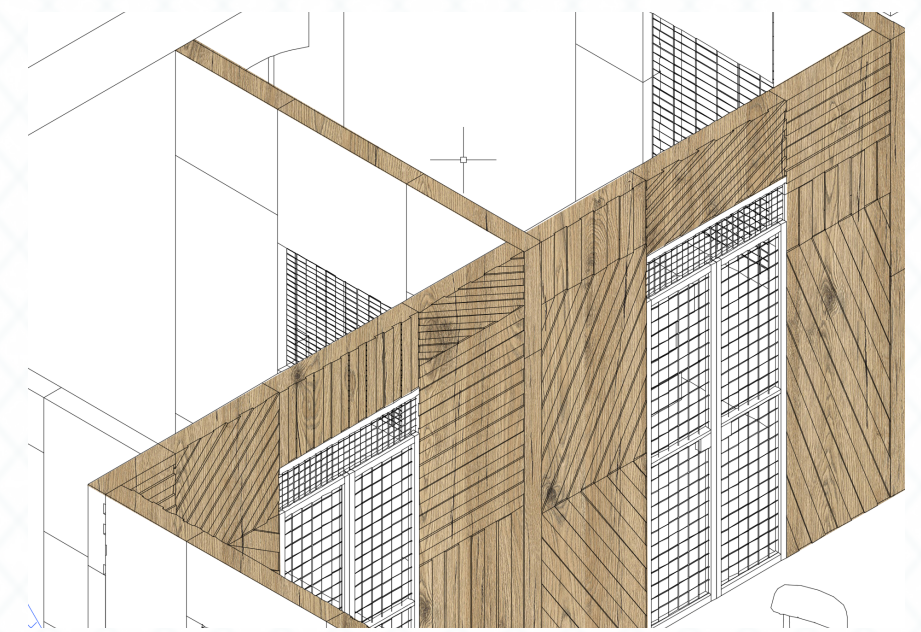
## Microtectonic - Bar Detail With Hatch Opening

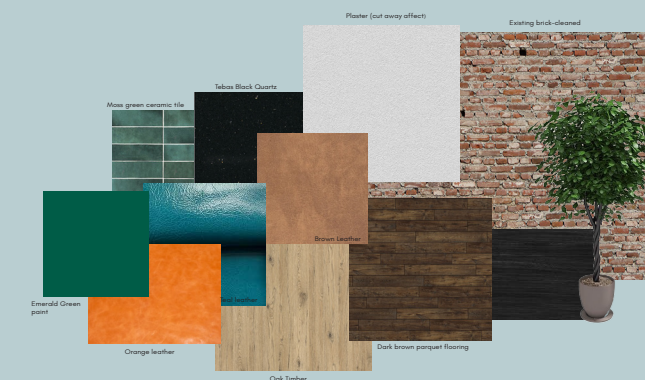
